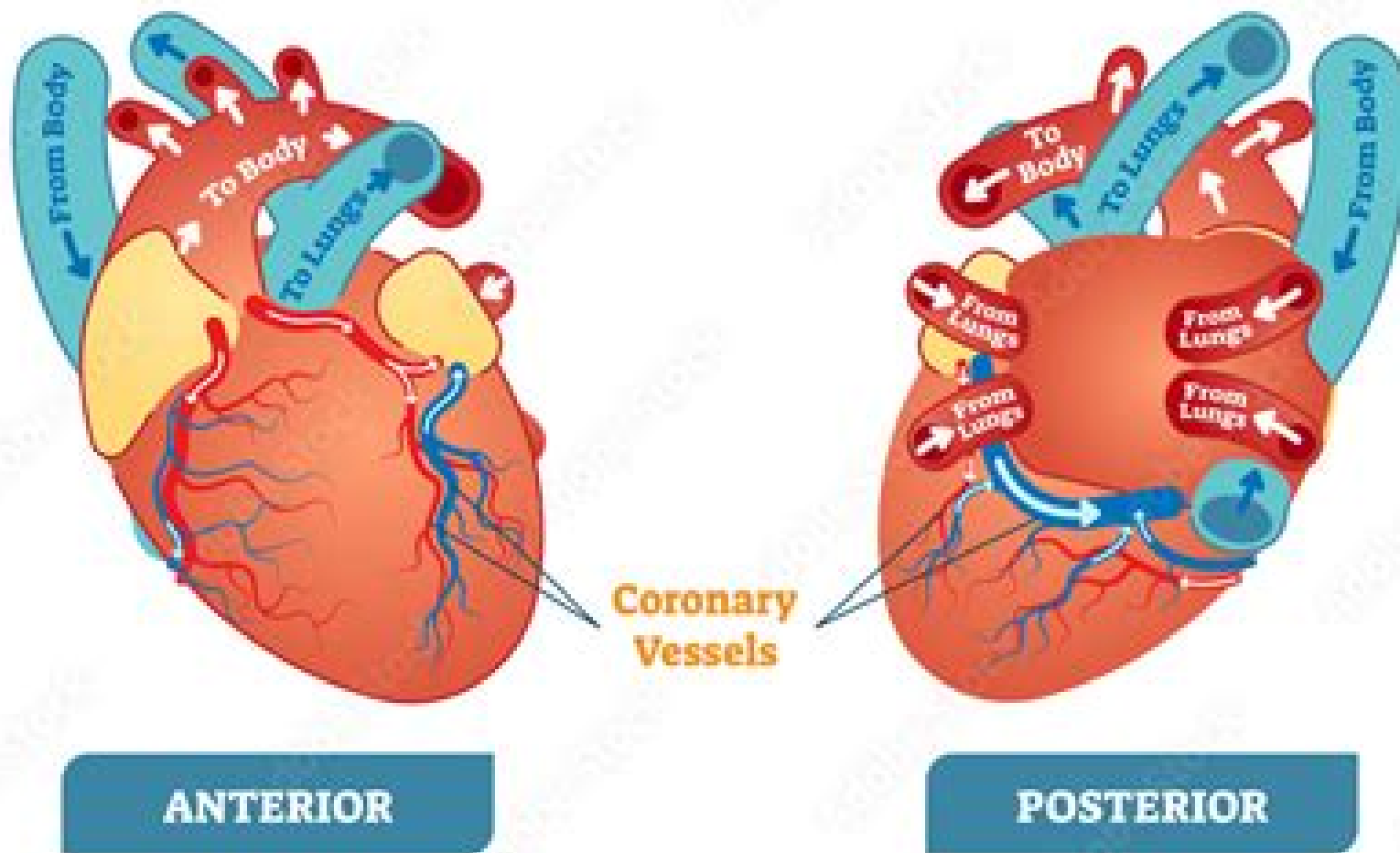
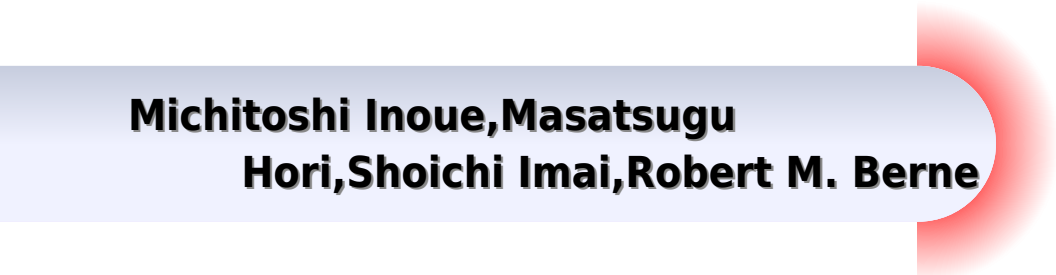

Hoffman, 2012-12-06 Coronary heart disease is one of the major health problems in industrialized nations because of its high incidence and severity Recent innovations in medical and surgical treatment of coronary heart disease have increased the importance of accurate diagnostic methods for determining the severity of coronary disease identifying potential treatment alternatives and evaluating the results of treatment Great advances have also been made in basic research on coronary circulation and its interaction with myocardial contraction and relaxation and neural and humoral control With respect to these developments the papers included in the present monograph deal with important topics concerned with the basic mechanism of coronary circulation as well as ones of clinical relevance It is directed toward physicians cardiologists cardiac surgeons cardiac radiologists anesthesiologists and others and basic scientists e.g. physiologists bioengineers We would like to emphasize the importance of a multidisciplinary approach in which basic scientists and clinicians work closely together This volume consists of nine chapters Chapter 1 contains macroscopic and microscopic descriptions of coronary vascular anatomy which is closely related to the functions of coronary circulation In Chap 2 two methods in current use to evaluate phasic coronary blood velocity waveforms are presented i.e. the laser Doppler and ultrasound Doppler methods Chapter 3 describes the mechanical properties of coronary circulation a knowledge of which is indispensable for an understanding of coronary arterial and venous blood flow velocity waveforms in relation to cardiac contraction and relaxation

Kaverina, 1965 Diseases associated with impairment of the coronary circulation are very common Hence the treatment of such diseases is a matter of considerable importance It is now considered one of the main problems of clinical medicine The basis for solving the problem is to enlarge our knowledge of the mechanisms of action of the drugs used to treat coronary insufficiency and to find new effective agents Owing to the complexity of physiological regulation of the coronary circulation there are many difficulties of a procedural order in studying it experimentally This was one of the reasons why ideas on the action of many pharmacological agents were derived until recently from the results of experiments involving the isolated heart When applied to the intact organism these ideas proved to be inexact and at times wrong Some ideas on the effects of certain drugs were based on experiments involving the intact organism but the data proved to be inexact due to the inadequacy of the method selected by the authors to determine the mechanism of action of a given substance Another reason for misconceptions of the effects of some drugs stemmed from insufficient knowledge and contradictory opinions expressed by various investigators on many aspects of the coronary circulation Now however advances in experimental techniques have produced new facts bearing on the physiological regulation of the cardiac blood supply This has given rise to the need to reexamine some matters concerned with the influence of pharmacological agents on the coronary circulation relying on modern ideas concerning its physiological regulation and using adequate experimental techniques Most drugs have complex mechanisms of action owing to the intimate relationship between the processes regulating the cardiac blood supply Elucidation of these mechanisms requires the use of various techniques each of which must be suited to the particular aspect under study This approach will result in a reappraisal of the action of several pharmacological agents on the coronary circulation Moreover we believe that the data in this book will be helpful in making more efficient use of these agents in the treatment of various forms of coronary insufficiency

the very highest levels into the many effects of hypoxia on humans and animals in health and disease Fundamentals of Anaesthesia Colin Pinnock, Ted Lin, Tim Smith, Robert Jones, 2002-01-12 Provides a comprehensive but easily readable account of all of the information required by the FRCA Primary examination candidate **Coronary flow reserve - measurement and application: Focus on transthoracic Doppler echocardiography** Pawel Petkow-Dimitrow, 2002-09-30 Coronary flow reserve is an important functional parameter to understand the pathophysiology of coronary circulation Coronary flow reserve measurement is used to assess epicardial coronary stenoses or to examine the integrity of microvascular circulation An appreciation of coronary physiology is an integral part of clinical decision making for cardiologists treating patients with coronary artery disease The pioneering research efforts of Dr Lance Gould who explored the relationship between the anatomic severity of a stenosis and its flow resistance 59 60 have been transferred to clinical practice 94 194 In the absence of stenosis in epicardial coronary artery the coronary flow reserve may be decreased when coronary microvascular circulation is compromised by arterial hypertension with or without left ventricular hypertrophy diabetes mellitus hypercholesterolemia or other diseases Several techniques have been established for measuring coronary flow reserve However these techniques are either invasive intracoronary Doppler flow wire highly expensive and scarcely available Positron Emission Tomography PET or semi invasive and causing patient discomfort transesophageal Doppler echocardiography thus their clinical use is limited Because of the clinical importance of coronary flow reserve there is a need for a simple noninvasive repeatable and inexpensive tool capable of this functional evaluation This monograph focuses on the assessment of coronary flow reserve using transthoracic Doppler echocardiography the technique fulfilling the above mentioned criteria Transthoracic Doppler echocardiography has become a popular tool evolving from a research to diagnostic technique applied in everyday practice

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
