



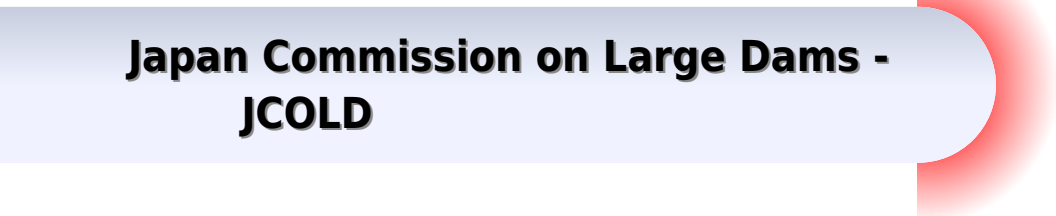

Tsutsui,2024-11-30 Japan s oceans demand our attention Violent prolific and changeful they define life and death on the archipelago pushing the shore under the rush of tsunami charging typhoon circulation feeding millions and

seeding conflicts over territory and resources And yet Japan studies remains largely beholden to a terrestrial view of the world that is at odds with the importance of the sea This terrestrial bias also means that on those occasions when oceans are recognized they are most often presented as dividers or connectors spaces in between rather than rich ecologies and meaningful sites Oceanic Japan is meant to help readers re envision Japanese history in order to show how the seas created the country that we know today The book convenes a diverse multinational multidisciplinary group of scholars to expand the scope of Japan studies and the field of environmental humanities The chapters draw from the broader turn to the sea characterized by new oceanic and terraqueous perspectives developing within these fields and in areas such as Pacific history and Indian Ocean studies The volume editors vision is bifocal On one hand they aim to reorient East Asian studies and Japan studies to the sea underlining how oceans have shaped dynamics from the Tokugawa Era forward into the age of empire and the crisis of the Anthropocene On the other hand they argue for a more nuanced environmental approach within the burgeoning field of Oceanic studies Seeing oceanic spaces as more than entrepots or political spheres requires thinking in new often vertical volumetric ways The chapters follow human and non human actors to recognize the variegation of watery ecologies through winds tides coasts seabeds and currents such as the Kuroshio and Oyashio which have always shaped life on the archipelago

Turbulent Streams Roderick I. Wilson, 2021-05-31 In *Turbulent Streams An Environmental History of Japan's Rivers 1600-1930* Roderick I. Wilson describes how the rivers of Japan are both hydrologically and historically dynamic Today these waterways are slowed channeled diverted and dammed by a myriad of levees multiton concrete tetrapods and massive multipurpose dams In part this intensive engineering arises from the waterways falling great elevations over short distances flowing over unstable rock and soil and receiving large quantities of precipitation during monsoons and typhoons But this modern river regime is also the product of a history that narrowed both these waterways and people's diverse interactions with them in the name of flood control Neither a story of technological progress nor environmental decline this history introduces the concept of environmental relations as a category of historical analysis both to explore these fluvial interactions and reveal underappreciated dimensions of Japanese history

Spiske,2016-04-14 This monograph is a compilation of a number of research studies presented in fourteen chapters dealing with the impact and restoration of coastal environments that have been affected by earthquakes and tsunamis The focus is mainly on rivers estuaries coastal lagoons beaches and related ecosystems In addition to direct impact and response due to flooding and subsequent abrasion this publication covers physical chemical and biological responses in coastal morphology water quality and ecosystems and includes also topics dealing with risk reduction and vulnerability This compilation mainly covers examples from large magnitude earthquake and tsunami events in the Indian and Pacific Ocean that are complemented with other events in Latin America and the Iberian Peninsula Comprehensive descriptions of multi scale impacts of tsunami and earthquake events both spatially and temporally will help the reader to understand the complicated interactions which occur in coastal zones in order to create a sustainable resilient environment and achieve a society with smart post event recovery planning This book is aimed at researchers and students in coastal science and engineering as well as at policy makers environmental planners and coastal managers

Finding Solace in the Soil Bonnie J. Clark,2020-12-07 Finding Solace in the Soil tells the largely unknown story of the gardens of Amache the War Relocation Authority incarceration camp in Colorado Combining physical evidence with oral histories and archival data and enriched by the personal photographs and memories of former Amache incarcerated the book describes how gardeners cultivated community in confinement Before incarceration many at Amache had been farmers gardeners or nursery workers Between 1942 and 1945 they applied their horticultural expertise to the difficult high plains landscape of southeastern Colorado At Amache they worked to form microclimates reduce blowing sand grow better food and achieve stability and preserve community at a time of dehumanizing dispossession In this book archaeologist Bonnie J Clark examines botanical data like seeds garden related artifacts and other material evidence found at Amache as well as oral histories from survivors and archival data including personal letters and government records to recount how the prisoners of Amache transformed the harsh military setting of the camp into something resembling a town She discusses the varieties of gardens found at the site their place within Japanese and Japanese American horticultural traditions and innovations brought about by the creative use of limited camp resources The gardens were regarded by the incarcerated as a gift to themselves and to each other And they were also it turns out a gift to the future as repositories of generational knowledge where a philosophical stance toward

nature was made manifest through innovation and horticultural skill Framing the gardens and gardeners of Amache within the larger context of the incarceration of Japanese Americans and of recent scholarship on displacement and confinement Finding Solace in the Soil will be of interest to gardeners historical archaeologists landscape archaeologists cultural anthropologists and scholars of Japanese American history and horticultural history Limnoperna Fortunei Demetrio Boltovskoy,2015-04-20 This book summarizes all currently available information on the ecology environmental impacts and control methods of the golden mussel in industrial plants The golden mussel was introduced in Hong Kong Taiwan Japan and South America between 1965 and 1990 swiftly spreading in freshwater waterbodies In most areas invaded it has become the dominant macroinvertebrate and a major fouling pest of industrial plants *Limnoperna fortunei* attaches to any hard surface as well as to some less firm substrates The growth of *Limnoperna* populations in raw cooling water conduits became a common nuisance in many industrial and power plants that use raw river or lake water for their processes both in South America and in Asia This work is written by experts on the golden mussel from Asia Europe North America and South America each chapter critically reviews previously available information which is in sources of limited distribution such as internal reports and theses in various languages

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
