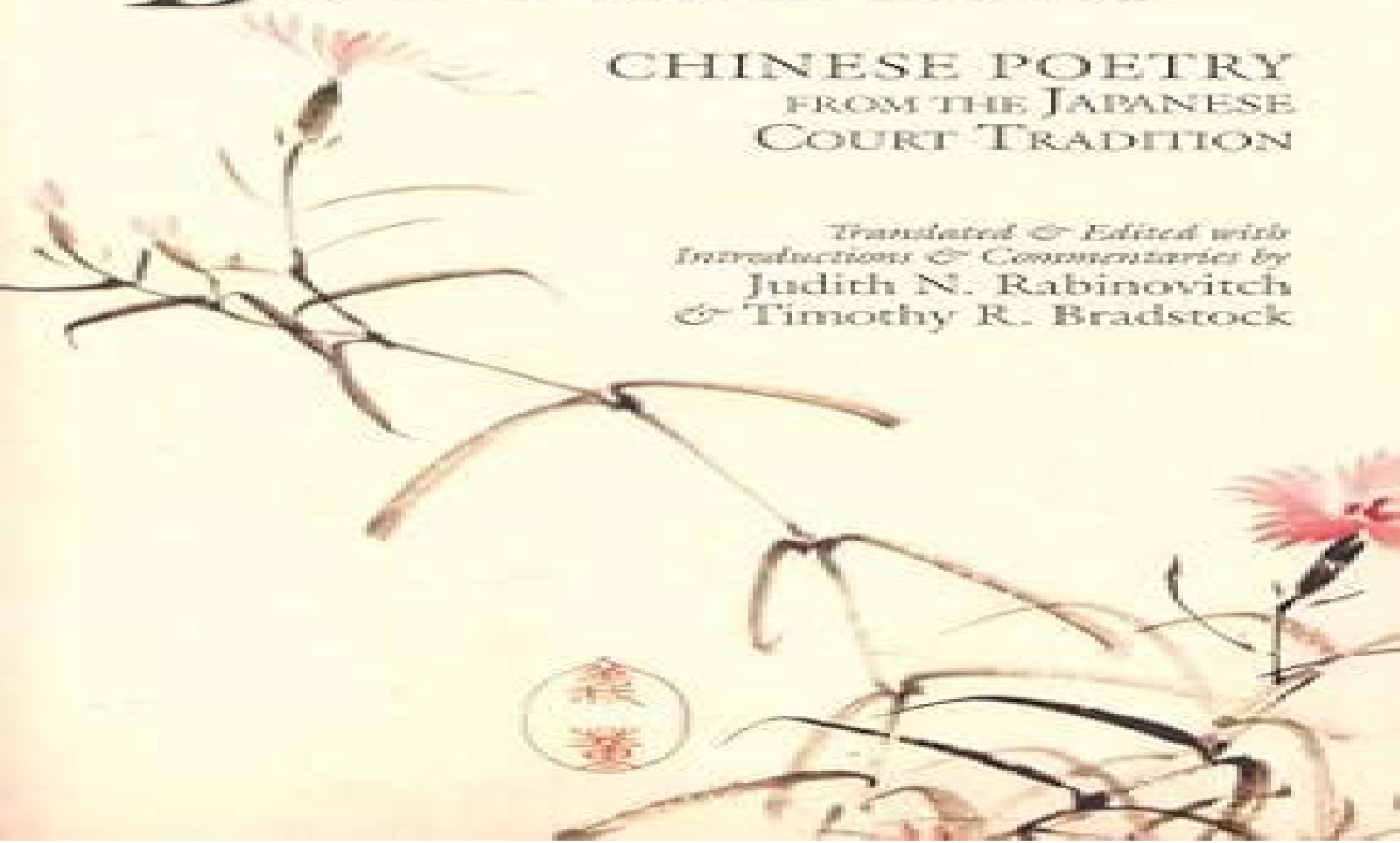

Rabinovitch, Timothy Roland Bradstock, 2005 The composition of Chinese poetry kanshi in the Japanese court dates to the mid seventh century During the Heian age 794 1185 kanshi emerged as one of two preeminent poetic genres employed by aristocrats scholar officials and priests over the centuries it developed into one of Japan s most enduring literary forms This anthology comprising some 300 kanshi by 80 poets is the largest collection of translated kanshi ever produced It includes an introduction to the kanshi genre biographies of the poets and extensive annotations The poems sketch a graceful panorama of life in the Heian capital and in the provinces offering rare glimpses into the private concerns tastes and aspirations of the well born people of the times Kanshi continued to flourish in Japan through early modern times remaining vital down to the Taisho era 1912 1926 Its longevity was partly a function of its permeation to the townsmen class and to a larger range of female practitioners Although the era of kanshi composition has passed some 5 million Japanese continue to participate in kanshi recitation circles While Japanese vernacular literature has been studied extensively and is relatively well known in the West kanshi have received little scholarly attention in either Japan or abroad It is hoped that the present anthology will bring this important genre more squarely into both the mainstream of Japanese studies and the consciousness of Western readers

celebration Chinese Literary Forms in Heian Japan reconstructs the lived practice of Chinese poetic and prose genres among Heian officials analyzing the material exchanges by which documents were commissioned the local reinterpretations of Tang aesthetic principles and the ritual venues in which literary Chinese texts were performed in Japanese vocalization Even as state ideology and educational institutions proclaimed the Chinese script s embodiment of timeless cosmological patterns everyday practice in this far flung periphery subjected classical models to a string of improvised exceptions Through careful comparison of literary and documentary sources this book provides a vivid case study of one society s negotiation of literature s position both within a hierarchy of authority and between the incommensurable realms of script and speech

The Capitalist Dilemma in China's Cultural Revolution Sherman Cochran, 2014-12-31 How can capitalists motivations during a Communist revolution be reliably documented and fully understood Up to now the answer to this question has generally eluded scholars who for lack of nonofficial sources have fallen back on Communist governments official explanations But the essays in this volume confirm that at least in the case of the Communist revolution in China it is finally possible to make new and fresh interpretations By focusing closely on individuals and probing deeply into their thinking and experience the authors of these essays have discovered a wide range of reasons for why Chinese capitalists did or did not choose to live and work under communism The

contributors to this volume have all concentrated on the dilemma for capitalists in China's Communist revolution. But their approach to their subject through archival research and rigorous analysis may also serve as a guide for future thinking about a variety of other historical figures. This approach is well worth adopting to explain how any members of society, not only capitalists, have resolved comparable dilemmas in all revolutions: the ones in China, Russia, Vietnam, Cuba, or anywhere else.

The Secret Island and the Enticing Flame Edwin A. Cranston, 2010-03-31. The three essays in this book draw on the translator's work on love poetry: classical waka and the tanka of Yosano Akiko (1878-1942) but also introduce the prose poems and free verse of a contemporary surrealist poet, Mizuno Ruriko, whose themes are childhood and the loss of innocence. The Secret Island and the Enticing Flame shows the translator of poetry experimenting with three different ways to present the results of his craft. In the Dark of the Year is an essay in sequencing. Cranston arranges translations of fifty love poems in the tanka form ranging from the ancient chronicle *Kojiki* to the contemporary poet Tawara Machi in an examination of desire, melancholy, and despair. The arrangement, inspired by the technique of association and progression, suggests an ongoing love story and limns the essence of the classical love tradition. Young Akiko: The Literary Debut of Yosano Akiko (1878-1942) adopts a biographical approach, richly documented with the astonishing tanka of the young poet who burst on the literary scene in 1900. This essay updates the author's article originally published in 1977 in *Literature East and West*. Finally, the longest essay, The Dark at the Bottom of the Dish: Fishing for Myth in the Poetry of Mizuno Ruriko, shows Cranston working outside his usual box on the poems of a contemporary surrealist whose deepest themes are childhood and loss of innocence. Mizuno, hitherto not well known outside Japan, is a master of the prose poem and free verse. Cranston's essay shows the translator searching for the mysterious power that draws him to a poetry quite different from any on which he has previously worked.

The Wind from Vulture Peak Stephen D. Miller, 2013-06-30. The Wind from Vulture Peak addresses the history of the gradual incorporation of Buddhist concepts into Heian waka poetry and the development among court poets of a belief in the production of that poetry as a Buddhist practice in itself.
