Singh, 2000-06-01 There has been a major shift in the way we conceptualize and provide services to children and adolescents with mental health needs We are moving away from the traditional disorder oriented model of treatment to a child centered family focused service delivery system that mandates mental health services in the context of the child s family and social ecology This new system of care has spawned many

variations of the model including wraparound services multisystemic treatment MST futures planning and person centred planning As systems of care are different across countries and cultures it is imperative that we share our knowledge and make explicit the lessons we have learned in our attempts to provide services to children and adolescents which focus on improving their quality of life rather than merely treating their psychiatric disorders and psychological problems There is an urgent need to evaluate the various treatments being offered to children and adolescents with mental health needs Empirical data on outcomes will determine the funding and delivery of services As such the latest research on treatment outcomes needs to be disseminated so that new and validated treatment methods can be implemented rapidly

Measuring the Effects of Racism Robert T. Carter, Alex L. Pieterse, 2020-07-21 A large body of research has established a causal relationship between experiences of racial discrimination and adverse effects on mental and physical health In *Measuring the Effects of Racism* Robert T Carter and Alex L Pieterse offer a manual for mental health professionals on how to understand assess and treat the effects of racism as a psychological injury Carter and Pieterse provide guidance on how to recognize the psychological effects of racism and racial discrimination They propose an approach to understanding racism that connects particular experiences and incidents with a person's individual psychological and emotional response They detail how to evaluate the specific effects of race based encounters that produce psychological distress and possibly impairment or trauma Carter and Pieterse outline therapeutic interventions for use with individuals and groups who have experienced racial trauma and they draw attention to the importance of racial awareness for practitioners The book features a racial trauma assessment toolkit including a race based traumatic stress symptoms scale and interview schedule Useful for both scholars and practitioners including social workers educators and counselors *Measuring the Effects of Racism* offers a new framework of race based traumatic stress that helps legitimize psychological reactions to experiences of racism

Mental Disorders in the Social Environment Stuart A. Kirk, 2005 Social workers provide more mental health services than any other profession yet recent biomedical trends in psychiatry appear to minimize the importance of their traditional concerns which focus on the social environment that accompanies mental disorders and their treatment In twenty four chapters written by distinguished scholars this book not only calls attention to this emerging problem and challenges conventional mental health beliefs and practices but also raises provocative questions Has social work become too closely associated with psychiatry and too quick to adopt a medical approach Has the focus on the therapeutic relationship negated social work's commitment to social reform Is the social worker marginalized by the emphasis in mental health on biochemistry and psychopharmacology This book calls on social workers and other health care professionals to be more skeptical about diagnosis community treatment evidence based practice psychotherapy medications and managed care

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
