Newburn, 2003-01-01 This collection explores the intersection between criminology conflict resolution and restorative justice It traces the role of criminological discourses in the resolution of conflict at the macro political level in South Africa and Northern Ireland and the micro level in settings such as local communities indigenous justice systems and in the youth justice system The resulting discourse drawing upon peacemaking criminology human rights and restorative justice frameworks suggests an important symbiosis between the traditionally distinct disciplines of criminology and conflict resolution peace studies Informal Reckonings Andrew Woolford, R.S. Ratner, 2008-01-15 The reparational turn in the field of law has resulted in the increased use of so called informal approaches to conflict resolution including primarily the three mechanisms considered in this book mediation restorative justice and reparations While proponents of these mechanisms have acclaimed their communicative and democratic promise critics have charged that mediation restorative justice and reparations all potentially serve as means for encouraging citizens to internalize and mimic the rationalities of governance Indeed the critics suggest that informal justice's supposed oppositional relationship to formal justice is at base a mutually reinforcing one in which each system relies on the other for its effective operation rather than the two being locked in a struggle for dominance This book contributes to the discussion of the confluence of informal and formal justice by providing a clearer picture of the justice field through the notion of the informal formal justice complex This term adapted from Garland and Sparks 2000 describes a cultural formation in which adversarial punitive and conciliatory restorative justice forms coexist in relative harmony despite their apparent contradictions Situating this complex within the context of neoliberalism this book identifies the points of rupture in the informal formal justice complex to pinpoint how and where a truly alternative and transformative justice i.e. a justice that challenges and counters the hegemony of formal legal practices opening the field of law to a broader array of actors and ideas might be established through the tools of mediation restorative justice and reparations **Handbook of Restorative Justice** Gerry Johnstone, Daniel Van Ness, 2013-01-11 This book provides a comprehensive and authoritative account and analysis of restorative justice one of the most rapidly growing phenomena in the field of criminology and justice studies This book aims to meet the need for a comprehensive reliable and accessible overview of the subject It draws together leading authorities on the subject from around the world in order to elucidate and discuss the key concepts and principles of restorative justice explain how the campaign for restorative justice arose and developed into the influential social movement it is today describe the variety of restorative justice practices explain how they have developed in various places and contexts and critically examine their rationales and effects identify and examine key tensions and issues within the restorative justice movement brings a variety of disciplinary and interdisciplinary perspectives to bear upon the understanding and assessment of restorative justice The Handbook of Restorative Justice is essential reading for students and practitioners in the field

Action Research in Criminal Justice Inge Vanfraechem, Ivo Aertsen, 2017-09-14 To understand how people experience justice and security is a challenging task in times of unrest marked by growing perceptions of insecurity discrimination and uncertainty The European project ALTERNATIVE aimed to understand justice and security experiences related to conflicts in intercultural settings when citizens are given the means to actively contribute to these processes This book relates how the project was set up as an action research through the concrete description of four action sites social housing estates in Vienna Austria a small community in Hungary with a Roma population three border towns in Serbia and three communities in Northern Ireland These four sites have been compared through an innovative methodology which leads to a deeper understanding of the impact of participatory and restorative justice oriented processes and in a more general way of what action research may entail in the criminological field Bringing together researchers and case studies from around Europe this book examines the scientific potential of action research as a methodology in criminal justice settings This book is one of two volumes resulting from the work by a group of researchers in six European countries having cooperated intensively during four years in ALTERNATIVE an action research project funded under the EU Seventh Framework Programme
