Based on ethnographically contextualized life stories and case studies of female and male entrepreneurs, the volume offers a vivid and multi-perspectival account of their strategies, visions and ventures in domains as varied as religious proselytism, politics, tourism, media, music, prostitution, funeral organization and education. African cultural entrepreneurs have a significant economic impact, attract the attention of large groups of people, serve as role models for many youths and contribute to the formation of new popular cultures.
