The Corfu Incident of 1923 James Barros, 1965 **Mussolini** Richard J. B. Bosworth, 2014-03-04 In 1945 disguised in German greatcoat and helmet Mussolini attempted to escape from the advancing Allied armies Unfortunately for him the convoy of which he was part was stopped by partisans and his features made so familiar by Fascist propaganda gave him away Within 24 hours he was executed by his captors joining those he sent early to their graves as an outcome of his tyranny at least one million people He was one of the tyrant killers who so scarred interwar Europe but we cannot properly understand him or his regime by any simple equation with Hitler or Stalin Like them his life began modestly in the provinces unlike them he maintained a traditional male family life including both wife and mistresses and sought in his way to be an intellectual He was cruel though not the cruelist his racism existed but never without the consistency and vigor that would have made him a good recruit for the SS He sought an empire but in the most part his was of the old fashioned costly nineteenth century variety not a racial or ideological imperium And self evidently Italian society was not German or Russian the particular patterns of that society shaped his dictatorship Bosworth's Mussolini allows us to come closer than ever before to an appreciation of the life and actions of the man and of the political world and society within which he operated With extraordinary skill and vividness drawing on a huge range of sources this biography paints a picture of brutality and failure yet one tempered with an understanding of Mussolini as a human being not so different from many of his contemporaries

Sovereignty at the Paris Peace Conference of 1919 Leonard V. Smith, 2018-03-02 We have known for many decades that the Paris Peace Conference of 1919 failed in the sense that it did not prevent the outbreak of World War II This book investigates not whether the Paris Peace Conference succeeded or failed but the historically specific international system it created It explores the rules under which that system operated and the kinds of states and empires that inhabited it Deepening the dialogue between history and international relations theory makes it possible to think about sovereignty at the Paris Peace Conference in new ways Sovereignty in 1919 was about not just determining of answers demarcating the international system but also the questions Sovereignty in 1919 was about remaking the world Most histories of the Paris Peace Conference stop with the signing of the Treaty of Versailles with Germany on 28 June 1919 Sovereignty at the Paris Peace Conference of 1919 considers all five treaties produced by the conference as well as the Treaty of Lausanne with Turkey in 1923 It is organized not chronologically or geographically but according to specific problems of sovereignty A peace based on justice produced a criminalized Great Power in Germany and a template problematically applied in the other treaties The conference sought to unmix lands and peoples in the defeated multinational empires by drawing boundaries and defining ethnicities The conference sought not so much to oppose revolution as to instrumentalize it in the new international system The League of Nations so often taken as the supreme symbol of the failure of the conference is better considered as a continuation of the laboratory of sovereignty established in Paris The Day the Great War Ended, 24 July 1923 Jay

Winter,2022-09-08 On 24 July 1923 the last Treaty ending hostilities in the Great War was signed at Lausanne in Switzerland That Treaty closed a decade of violence Jay Winter tells the story of what happened on that day On the shores of Lake Geneva diplomats statesmen and soldiers came from Ankara and Athens from London Paris and Rome and from other capital cities to affirm that war was over The Treaty they signed fixed the boundaries of present day Greece and Turkey and marked a beginning of a new phase in their history That was its major achievement but it came at a high price The Treaty contained within it a Compulsory Population Exchange agreement By that measure Greek Orthodox citizens of Turkey with the exception of those living in Constantinople lost the right of citizenship and residence in that state So did Muslim citizens of Greece except for residents of Western Thrace This exchange of nearly two million people introduced to the peace conference by Nobel Prize winner and humanitarian Fridtjof Nansen provided a solution to the immense refugee problem arising out of the Greek Turkish war At the same time it introduced into international law a definition of citizenship defined not by language or history or ethnicity but solely by religion This set a precedent for ethnic cleansing followed time and again later in the century and beyond The second price of peace was the burial of commitments to the Armenian people that they would have a homeland in the lands from which they had been expelled tortured and murdered in the genocide of 1915 This book tells the story of the peace conference and its outcome It shows how peace came before justice and how it set in motion forces leading to the global war that followed in 1939 *Mussolini, Mustard Gas and the Fascist Way of War* Charles

Stephenson,2024-04-18 An examination of the first conflict to see the large scale systematic deployment of chemical weaponry since the end of World War I In early October 1935 and without any declaration of war some two hundred thousand men comprising soldiers and airmen of the Italian armed forces Fascist Blackshirt Militia Eritrean ascari and Somali dubats invaded the independent state of Ethiopia Abyssinia It was an operation entirely of choice the chooser being Il Duce Benito Mussolini The resultant conflict is often described as a colonial war while it was certainly launched with the intent of turning Ethiopia into an Italian possession it was in fact a war of aggression against an independent sovereign state with membership of the League of Nations A state that had according to one of its nineteenth century rulers been for fourteen centuries a Christian island in a sea of pagans The swiftness of the Italian victory resulted from their possession and ruthless use of technology most particularly aircraft mustard gas and motorisation mechanisation Since they were fighting an enemy who possessed none of these things then they were able to wage indeed inaugurate what the prominent military theorist JFC Fuller dubbed totalitarian warfare or as it became known a few years later total war This he opined was the Fascist the scientific way of making war In his considered view the Fascist Army that waged it was a scientific military instrument This book examines that campaign in military and political terms **Duce: The Contradictions of Power** Peter J. Williamson,2023-06-15 Eighty years after the fall of Benito Mussolini controversy remains about what his dictatorship represented This reflects the different sides to the Duce s leadership while adept at nurturing and enforcing his personal

political power Mussolini's lack of insight into the requirements of governance prevented him from converting this power into influence to achieve his goals. His efforts to maintain the support of Italy's conservative elites economic social and political also created tensions with his radical Fascist ambitions diminishing the momentum behind his regime. Mussolini is frequently portrayed as a charismatic leader but his rule was secured principally by coercion violence and a spoils system. Nonetheless his personality cult had significant popular appeal even if based upon a political myth. This enabled him to consolidate his position and to dominate his Fascist colleagues but at a price of over centralized dysfunctional decision making. In this book the first comprehensive English language study of Mussolini in nearly two decades Peter J Williamson brings to life the contradictions within the Duce's leadership. Using a wide range of sources Williamson reveals how these conflicts impeded the dictator's ambitions leaving him increasingly frustrated all while most Italians endured the severe privations of both failure and Fascism.
